

- Support diverse range of customers – land managers, government officials, aviation, marine, public, etc.










Challenges in Lakeshore Flood Prediction

- 1. Limited experience
- 2. Limited reports of flooding/damage



Initial Local Research

Duluth Water Level Observation Data

Nov 26-27, 2001 – "Lakewalk Damaged" → 602.6'

Oct 27, 2017 – "Storm #1" \rightarrow 604.36"

Apr 13-15, 2018 – "Storm #2" \rightarrow 603.14"

Oct 10-11, 2018 – "Storm #3" \rightarrow 604.24"

Apr 11, 2019 – "Almost Storm #4" → 603.77"

Oct 21, 2019 – "Storm #5" \rightarrow 604.75"






Initial Local Research

Duluth Water Level Observation Data

- Anecdotally, it seems like 604' almost always produces damage
- There is a duration factor in winds/waves, but we're still learning!

Lakeshore Flooding Products

Lakeshore Flood WATCH

Lakeshore flooding that may have significant impacts (12-48 hours in advance)

Lakeshore Flood WARNING

Lakeshore flooding which poses a serious threat to life and property is occurring, imminent, or highly likely (12-24 hours in advance)

Lakeshore Flood Advisory

Minor flooding is occurring or is possible (12-24 hours in advance)
